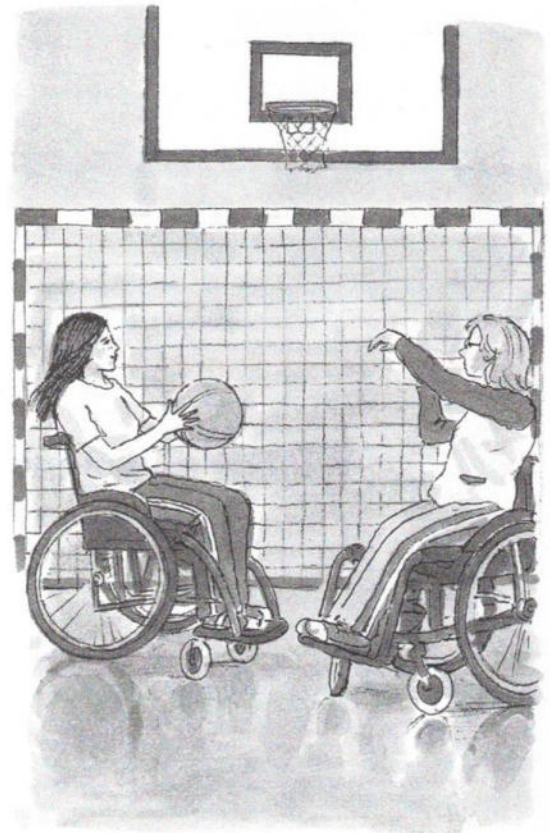
## What I do in my free time
