Latisha Oh. Thanks, Anna.

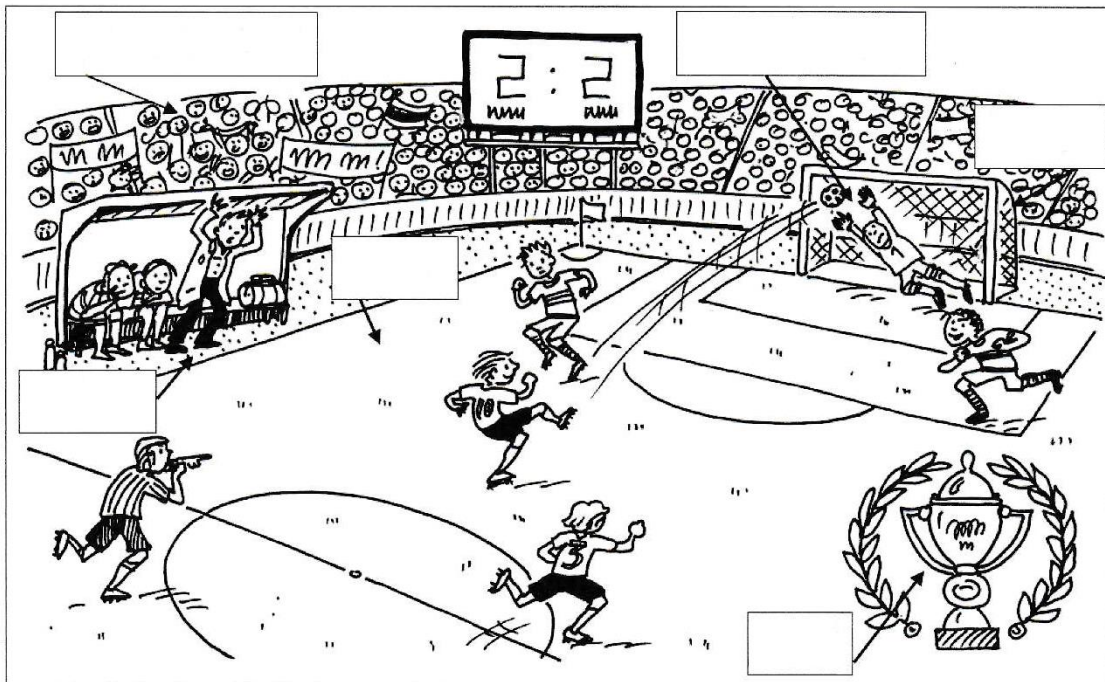
